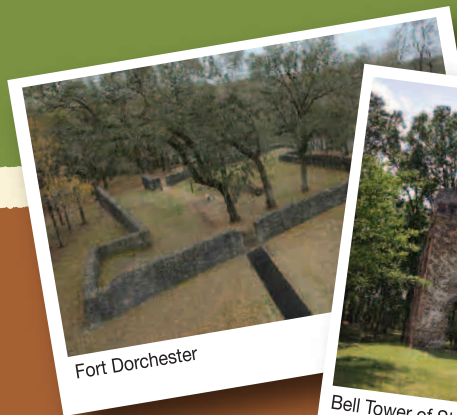


5 THINGS YOU MUST DO AT Colonial Dorchester State Historic Site

- 1 See part of a log wharf visible at low tide on the Ashley River that was once used as a highway for a trading town.
- 2 Take a self-guided rare look at a remarkably preserved past and tour the site of a former village.
- 3 Explore the historic cemetery and the intact remains of the old brick bell tower of St. George's Anglican Church.
- 4 See the fort, built in 1757, made of oyster-shell concrete called tabby, the best-preserved tabby fortification in the country.
- 5 View an archaeological treasure where visitors can watch as archaeologists unearth the settlement's history.
