Chester State Park's new disc golf facility includes both 9- and 18-hole courses, which cover more than 40 acres throughout the park's pine forest. Access to both courses is included with standard park admission, and both are open during normal park hours.

Chester State Park also has its own personalized discs and T-shirts for sale, as well as three-disc sets that can be rented for the entire day. These sets include a fairway driver, a midrange disc and a putter disc.

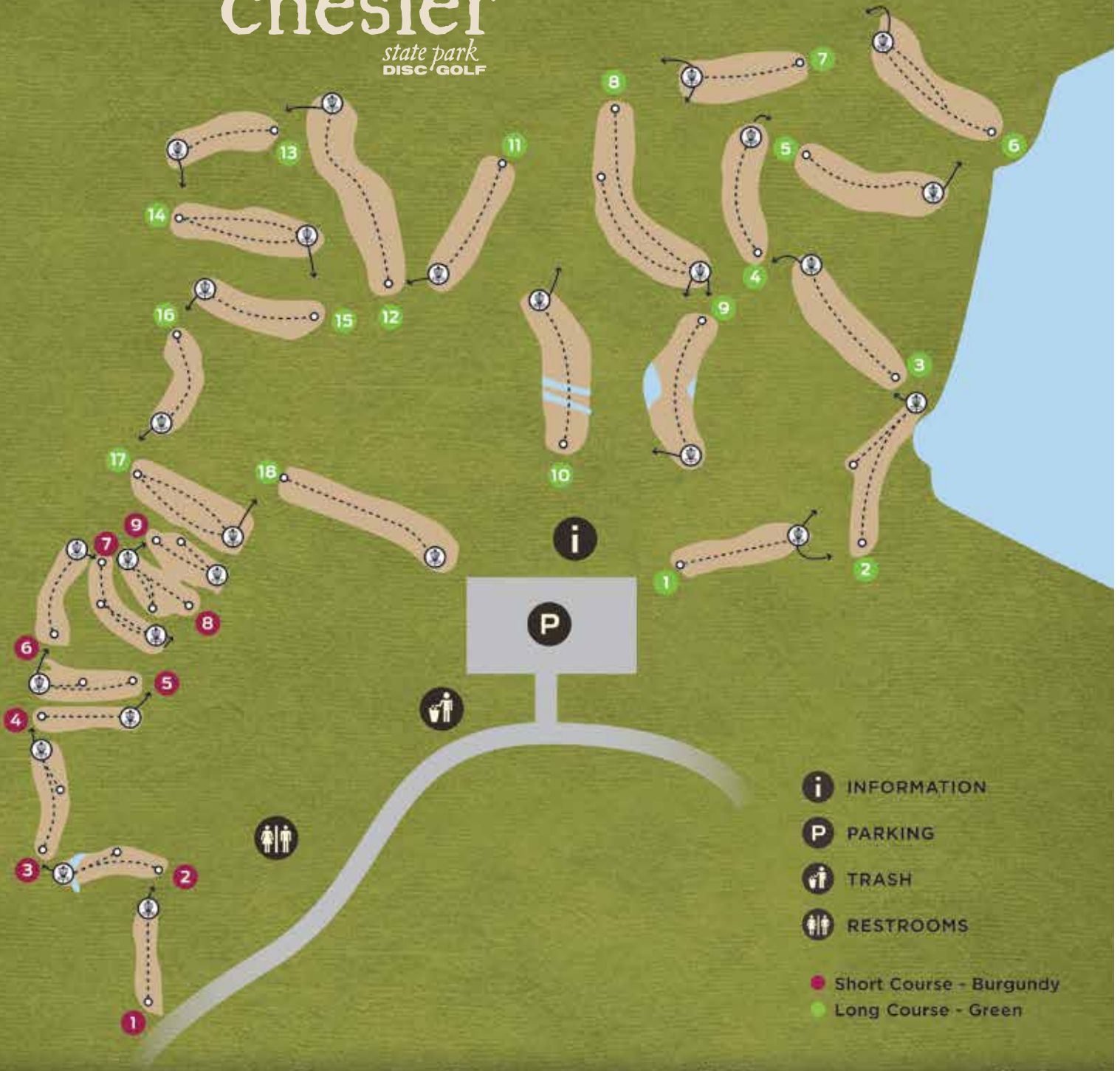

CHOOSING A COURSE

Whether you want to play 9 or 18 holes, we have two courses to choose from. Be mindful of the tee markers for your course, as some course paths overlap.

PLAYING DISC GOLF

The object of disc golf is to have fun and complete the course in the fewest throws. The competitor who plays the stipulated round or rounds in the fewest throws plus penalty throws is the winner.

COURSE SAFETY
