



# Solar Eclipse Viewing Party

## *At Chester State Park*

Where are you watching the eclipse? Come out to Chester State Park to experience the first total solar eclipse visible from coast to coast since 1918! At 2:45 pm, South Carolina will be dark as midnight! Drop by to discover how and why solar eclipses occur, then watch the show from land or by boat. Bring your own solar glasses or buy them at the park's Ranger Station (supplies limited, best to buy in advance). Adults must accompany children 16 and under.

**When:** August 21, from 12pm to 4pm

**Where:** Shelter 3

**Cost:** Free with Park Admission  
(\$2 per Adult, Free for Kids 15 & Under)

**What to Bring:** Drinks, snacks, sunscreen, camera, solar glasses (purchase at the park while supplies last) and a lawn chair or blanket.
