**Program Descriptions – Free with park admission unless otherwise noted**

**Art Near the Oaks-** Get your ART on! Be inspired as you create a colorful acrylic sea turtle on canvas. Check the flyer for the painting design. Enjoy a breathtaking view of the ocean surrounded by majestic oak trees. This guided outdoor painting session is led by a local art teacher, so all levels are welcome. \$25 per person and registration is required. All supplies included. In case of inclement weather, the program will be held inside the activity center. (2 hours)

**Backyard Bird ID-** We will spend time at our outdoor feeding station where we will spot some common birds and learn a bit more! This informal program is designed for people new to birdwatching. For kids ages 8 to 108! (30 minutes)

**Feeding Time-** Watch a snake eat a mouse and see what hungry animals lurk in our house! Ages 5 to 105! (30 minutes)

**Garbage Monster Story Time-** Have fun with this engaging and interactive story about trash and recycling. This is a perfect way to encourage young kids how easy it is to recycle! Appropriate for ages 4 to 8. (30 minutes)

**Nature's Nasties-** Watch out! There are all sorts of things outside that can get you! Ever worry about jellyfish, copperheads, poison ivy, or other scary animals? This fun program will reveal myths and help you identify some potential dangers of our wonderful outdoor wonderland and ways to avoid them. Appropriate for ages 8 to 108! (45 minutes)

**Snakes and Lizards-** If a lizard has no legs, does that make it a snake? Come find out how to tell the difference between these reptiles. Using skins, skulls, models, and live animals, discover the variety of snakes and lizards commonly seen in Myrtle Beach State Park. For ages 5 to 105! (45 minutes)

**Coming soon: November 19, 2016- Live Birds of Prey in Flight!**

Enjoy an awe inspiring free flight raptor demonstration from the SC Center for Birds of Prey. Watch live birds soar above and around you as you marvel at their unique hunting and flying techniques.
