Program Descriptions- Programs Free with Park Admission

Park Palooza!- Get outside and have some fun while participating in an extravagant array of activities! Various programs will continuously run from 10 am to 3 pm. Throw a cast net, plant a tree, learn about earth friendly products, build a campfire, use a compass, crawl through a shrimp net, check for nesting birds, and much more! Who's Home?- Take a ½ mile walk around the park to check bird houses to see who's nesting, if any eggs have been laid, and who's hatching. Wear close toed shoes. (1 hour)

Something's Fishy!- Reel in the knowledge as we fish for fin-tastic fishy facts! With the help of fishy activities, we will learn why fish are shaped differently, why they are important, and what fish can be caught off our pier. (1 hour)

Feeding Time- Come by the nature center and see what animals are being fed and what they eat during this informal program. (30 minutes)

Planet Jeopardy- Do you want to make a difference? Come play games that teach you how easy it can be to turn your daily actions into positive impacts on the environment at home, Myrtle Beach State Park, and where ever else you may go! This program is fun for all ages!! (1 hour)

From the Forest to the Sea- Experience the natural wonders of Myrtle Beach State Park! The maritime forest will be the gateway that leads us into the vast beauty of the maritime grassland where we will observe colorful flowers, search for fluttering butterflies and see what other critters we may encounter.
